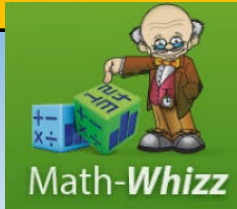
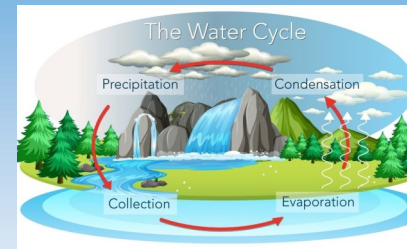

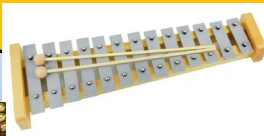
In English we are excited to explore a new poet (Donna Ashworth) as our hook for our initial topic "All About Me!". We move on to a novel study with the author Dick King Smith. This will cover text analysis, character descriptions, exploring sentences and vocabulary. Report writing skills will be tackled via a media clip. A practical activity in DT will support our instructional writing. Comprehension skills will be taught continuously and we will be developing these, as well as focusing on the fluency and prosody of reading aloud. English lessons will always begin with our TEnglish activities—ten minutes of 'quick fire' tasks. These cover handwriting, grammar and the ever popular Word of the Week!

In PE we will be expressing ourselves through dance and gymnastics. We will also be developing our throwing and catching skills through Tag Rugby and handball.

In DT we will be designing and making muffins, using a variety of seasonal fruits.



In music we will learn and perform songs for our Christmas show and develop our skills in using glockenspiels.



In RE we will be reflecting on the importance of the Harvest celebration, why harvests fail and why there is hunger in the world. We will focus on reducing waste as part of the Zero Hunger-Zero Waste project. Also we will look at Christianity and the question—Where do religious beliefs come from?



In Art we will be looking at artists from our country. We will use sketch pencils, textured paint and will learn how to print.



In French we will learn the vocabulary for fruit and developing confidence in speaking aloud.

We will look at the geography of our class country and study landmarks and use Google Earth.
