

In maths we will be using and applying our maths skills to solve real-life problems and investigations. We will learn about shape, angles, fractions, money and also focus on statistics. We will practise reading and telling the time.

In PE we will develop our understanding of crickets, rounders and athletics.



In Art we will be learning how to tie-dye and look at the work of tie-dye artists.

We begin the term exploring suspense narratives in writing; looking at the key features and developing our own characters and stories using inspiration from a text. We will also be looking at stories that raise issues, allowing us to complete oral and written work. An exciting new development in TEnglish this term will be "Talkie Tuesdays" where we will be developing oracy skills. These will teach valuable lessons that will be transferred to all other subjects and school life. Reading and comprehension skills will run alongside all topics - with a strong emphasis on reading fluency.



In history we will be learning about Anglo Saxons. We will be looking at the countries they travelled from and the influence they had on life in England today. We will explore and similarities and differences between village life today and in Anglo Saxon times.

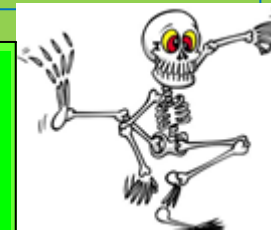
In music we will be learning how to play the recorder.

In DT we will be making pop-up books and sharing them with the infant children.



In computing we will learn how to use microbits. We will gather weather data and use Excel to present it.

In Science we will be learning about different animal skeletons. We will be learning about how muscles work and the purpose of different types of teeth. We will also learn about the digestive system and what happens when we eat.



In geography we will be learning about counties in the UK, including Essex. We will then focus on Ingatestone drawing a sketch map of a route from our school to the park and then carry out a walk following our maps.

In RE we will be learning about Pentecost, The Holy Trinity and the Lord's Prayer.

In PSHE we will be talking about 'Relationships'. We will discuss how to resolve jealousy, how to deal with love and loss, as well as thinking about positive friendships.

In French we will learn vocabulary around the theme of greetings, nationality, numbers, age and where we live.
