

In maths we will be learning about place value, partitioning, ordering numbers and placing numbers on number lines. We will compare and round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. We will develop written calculations for addition and subtraction and learn how to apply this to problem solving. We will extend our knowledge of all times tables and learn how to group numbers to multiply and divide.



In computing we will develop word processing skills, altering fonts and adding images. We will develop coding skills by creating animations, using Scratch and use Google Earth.

In French we will learn how to use verbs and say what we can and can't do.



In PSHE we will be establishing Class and School rules and expectations. We will be discussing Zones of Regulation and producing our own toolkit. We will discuss 'Being Me in my World' and celebrate differences.

We begin the year using a new book as a focus for our class reading and writing skills. This will give us an opportunity to develop English skills and analyse the text. We will continue our learning over the term by using a variety of hooks including a short media clip and a playscript. Our focus will also be handwriting and presentation, grammar and punctuation. Spellings will be discussed and tested weekly.

## Around the World!

### Years 3 and 4 Autumn Term 2026

In RE we will be reflecting on the importance of the Harvest and the wonders of nature, ending with a Harvest service. We will also explore aspects of Incarnation through the Gospels and the Nativity story. We will examine diversity of belief in Christianity and look at the Trinity.

In science this term we will be learning about sound. We will be doing lots of practical work and carrying out experiments.

In music we will learn songs for our Christmas production.

In D and T we will be thinking about how musical instruments make sound and making our own instruments using modelling materials.



We will be doing tag rugby and football. The children will create gymnastic sequences and dances for our Christmas show.

We are learning about the geography of our class countries. Looking at their locations in the world in relation to the UK, their climate and physical geographic features. We will learn about and use geographical language. We will also study some historical events from our class country.

In art we will use a range of media, including charcoal, oil pastels and paint. We will study an artist from our country and develop artistic language. We will experiment with collage and will evaluate our work and suggest improvements.
